Come and explore nature's playground. Our region has some of the most diverse experiences in Australia, meaning you can be mountain-biking one day, water-skiing the next, stargazing at night and maybe even petting a rhino in between.

Your overnight stay might include sleeping on a houseboat, overlooking the historic twin bridges or even waking up to hear the rumble of supercars from Pit Lane. For those looking to relax it could include lazy days with views of the river, lakes or Coorong in a luxury holiday home, floating pod accommodation or even glamping in a private wetland. All of this (and more) is possible here.

Our waterways begin in the lower Murray near Swan Reach. This stretch boasts some of the river's widest expanses and most spectacular ochre cliff faces. Not to mention, we're home the River Murray International Dark Sky Reserve – arguably the best place in the world to see the stars.

From here, we follow the <u>Mighty Murray</u> <u>Way</u> towards Mannum and Murray Bridge, two of our larger river towns.

Both have huge riverfront recreation areas with restaurants and show off our rich paddle steamer history. These idyllic spots are home to major events, playgrounds, skate parks, has.

walking trails and offer a great place to soak up river life.

In Murray Bridge you can host a function at Bridges Event Centre,

stay at the six-storey <u>Bridgeport Hotel</u> overlooking the riverfront and take a quick trip to <u>Monarto Safari Park</u> to visit the lemurs and lions.

South towards the Lower Lakes is the Murray Mouth and Coorong - one of the most unique environments in the world. Along the way, you'll go through Tailem Bend, now firmly on the map thanks to the Shell V-Power Motorsport Park. Further south, you'll start catching glimpses of Lake Albert and Lake

Alexandrina, as they begin to open up to the Coorong National Park.

Our region has some of the most diverse experiences in Australia. The lakeside town of Meningie is set right on Lake Albert and known for spectacular sunsets and fresh seafood. On the other side of the Coorong, you can travel through Lake

Alexandrina towns (such as Milang and Clayton Bay) on your way to Goolwa, where the Murray meets the sea.

But make sure you plan some time to stop off in one of South Australia's best wine regions – Langhorne Creek – for a day of gastronomic delights and vineyard views! Otherwise, if you're headed towards the Mallee, stop off for an evening lightshow at the Karoonda Silos, or explore the Mallee Tourist and Heritage Centre.



Whether you're a family that loves to go off the beaten track, splash

around in our waterways or get hands-on with wild adventures, there's a perfect holiday here.

You can move from a meerkat mingle to superslides and skateparks. Or strap on sneakers for a hike amongst the Mannum waterfalls, exploring nature playgrounds, frisbee golf and bunyips.

Outdoor adventures are why families return each year (and we're only a one-hour drive from Adelaide).

Things to add to your itinerary include fishing or paddling along the river, or a visit to Karoonda's new space-themed playground featuring a three-level tower and custom-built moon Lunar Rover. The hands-on moving displays

Here you can get an up-close wildlife experience at Monarto Safari Park, ride down Murray Bridge's superslide or go fishing in the Coorong National Park. at the Mannum Dock Discovery Centre are a hit with kids too, where your little 'captain' can steer the wheel, blow whistles and talk through brass funnels.

Our flat terrain and mild winters, mean our trails are

accessible all year round. So - whether you're a paddler, runner, walker or cyclist - you've got places to move. Even the newly redeveloped Monarto Safari Park has extensive trails, meaning you can have some seriously upclose encounters with the wild, while exercising too.

Our biggest trail is the 325km Lavender Federation Trail, a favourite with bushwalkers. It starts in Murray Bridge and winds through diverse countryside – a highlight being Kinchina Conservation Park, just outside Murray Bridge. The Mannum Waterfalls are also a stunning hike.

Paddle and explore

The Lower Murray Canoe Trail around Tailem Bend and Wellington provides people an up-close experience with the river ecosystems, and offers options for beginner to advanced. The Mannum Canoe Trail has a history focus, as it shows you a view of the PS Marion. Or, if you're after a guided tour to some of our most pristine parts of the Coorong (many only accessible by kayak), then Canoe the Coorong or Freedom Boat Hire is for you.

The Encounter Bikeway begins along the Murray River in Goolwa and takes you along the river's edge to the barrage. You'll pedal under the Hindmarsh Bridge and through the wharf precinct.

Renowned for its cycling culture, Goolwa cafés will welcome cyclists. The 300km

Parts of the 450km Murray Coorong Trail are now open. This walking and mountain

bike trail offers incredible views of the river, Lower Lakes and Coorong. Sections of between 2-20km will take vou along various surfaces, around the township of Mannum, through pine forests near Tailem Bend, along Sturt Reserve in Murray Bridge and from Meningie to the Coorong's edge. Shorter trails include the Tailem Bend History Trail or Murray Bridge Discovery Trail.

For riverside views and native wildlife, try the Pelican Path in Meningie, Swanport and Rocky Gully Wetlands in Murray Bridge, or the Goolwa Barrage walk to the Murray Mouth.



This beautifully restored vessel offers up two and five-night cruises, and has a lunch cruise every Monday from the Mannum riverfront.

Both cruises include onshore excursions, onboard entertainment and all of your dining needs.

If you're looking for a day-trip, try the historic PS Marion and PW Mayflower

(both based in Mannum), the <u>Captain Proud</u> (Murray Bridge) or the PS Oscar W (Goolwa).

Hear the sounds of wildlife and see the towering ochrecliffs by day.

Speed up

Another way to experience the Murray and Coorong is on board some of our smaller vessels for a guided tour. These faster cruises take you everywhere from the Murray

Mouth at Goolwa, right across Lake Alexandrina, through the Coorong National Park and further up river to townships such as Swan Reach. Based at Goolwa, the team from <u>Spirit</u> of the <u>Coorong Cruises</u> offer everything from two-hour to seven night guided tours - and will take you to places you never knew existed.

Go your own pace

A houseboat is one of the best ways to experience the river. Grab your friends and explore the stunning scenery from a bubbling on-board jacuzzi, set up on shore for a campfire, or bring the speedboat for on-water action. Start planning with the <u>SA Houseboat Hirers Association</u>, or <u>Unforgettable Houseboats</u>.

Whatever wild adventure your heart craves, our region will have something to try during your next trip. Our spectacular waterways, dark skies, native animals, African safari and unique landscapes are some of our greatest assets.

Switch off, and get back to nature

Camping, bushwalking, mountain biking, fishing, four-wheel driving and kayaking all work together here. Every day we see 4WDs loaded up for an off-road adventure. Start at the freshwater end, camping along the banks of Swan Reach or Walker Flat, before you head along the Mighty Murray Way towards campsites at

Mannum and Murray Bridge. From here, you can explore the Lower Lakes and Coorong for a saltier experience and feel a million miles away from civilisation. If you love fishing, try for a giant mulloway or even a fresh callop without having to board a boat! A must for nature lovers is a day tour with the team from Spirit of the Coorong (Goolwa) or Coorong Wildside Tours (Meningie). Both are local experts and will show you how to catch and prepare local seafood, and guide you through up-close wildlife experiences only accessible by boat.

Twitch, twitch

Twitchers love the region for its incredible variety of birdlife and conservation areas. Of course, the gem of the region is the Jack's Point Pelican Observatory down near Salt Creek, but there's much more. A few years back, the almost extinct Mallee Emu Wren was

released back in to Ngarkat
Conservation Park, and near
Tailem Bend you'll find plenty
of unique native birds at the
volunteer-run Pangarinda
Botanic Garden. At the other
end of our region, we have the
Lower Murray backwaters and
lagoons which are home to a
variety of ducks, herons and
bitterns. Places to view these
birds include hides at Mannum
(Hermann Gass Reserve),

Goolwa and Murray Bridge (Riverglades and <u>Swanport Wetlands</u>).

A wild tour in style

If you want a guided wildlife tour in luxury, then jump on board the famous Juggle House Experiences limo bus.



Everyone loves a road trip, and with a region full of adventure, history and sights, you need to spend a few days with us.

Swan Reach

Grab a bite to eat at the <u>Swan Reach</u> <u>Hotel</u>. Stay a night here to see the breathtaking <u>River Murray International</u> <u>Dark Sky Reserve</u>. It's the first of its kind in Australia and only the 16th in the world. For a culturally enriching experience, book a guided tour of the <u>Ngaut Ngaut Conversation Park</u>, located between Swan Reach and Nildottie. The traditional owners will teach you about the history and stories of this area and the Nganguraku people.

Karoonda

A detour to Karoonda will be well worth the trip. The award-winning silo art, including a night time illumination show, has brought this Mallee town global attention. There's also a great new space-themed playground for kids nearby if you have the little ones with you. Otherwise, if you're more interested in history, drop into Pioneer Park.

Bowhill

Find yourself watching the water-skiers whiz past showing off their best moves, or one of the local paddlesteamers cruising past.

Mannum

Next you'll come to the dual ferry crossing at Mannum (which is a great way to view the river). Mannum is the home of <u>PS Marion</u> and PW Mayflower. Both of these beautifully restored vessels allow you to experience the nostalgia of historic maritime experiences.

Plus, if you like to hike, then you'll love Mannum Waterfalls. This popular bush walking destination follows along Reedy Creek right up to the falls.

Murray Bridge

Driving south from Mannum will land you in Murray Bridge. A quick walk into the town will greet you with shops and cafés. Or to take in the local history, spend time at the restored Round House, overlooking the twin bridges and offering a 180-degree panoramic view of the river. Here you can take a history tour (bookings essential), or just wander around the gardens yourself – it's open to the public.

Across the road you'll find the award-winning <u>Bridgeport Hotel</u>. The modern interior will blow you away, so head inside and see it for yourself (or stay the night and wake up with river views).

Extend your stroll down to Sturt Reserve where you'll pass the rowing club, grass tennis courts, waterfront café, iconic views and the 'dreaded' bunyip. Keep following the tracks through wetlands to Long Island Reserve, or visit the Swanport Wetlands where you can stroll along boardwalks or watch the birds from custom-built viewing hides. Plus, you can't leave without adding Monarto Safari Park to your itinerary (and meet the new lemur family).

Tailem Bend

Tailem Bend has put itself on the map with its world-class Shell V-Power Motorsport Park. Between the impressive race circuit, rally, offroad tracks, 4WD adventure park, new drag way and karting course, you can spend an adrenalin-fueled day here. It's also got a bar and restaurant, plus showroom of some of the world's most incredible cars on display.



Stay the night here in the Rydges Pit Lane Hotel, or Big 4 Holiday Park.

Nearby Tailem Bend is Wellington East and the much-loved Pangarinda Botanic Garden. If you love native flowers – this is a must-see.

Meningie

Further down is the gorgeous lakeside town of Meningie. Here you can step out onto the jetty and get a close-up view of Lake Albert's magnificent scenery. If you have time, finish your trip a down south in the Coorong National Park (if you're in a 4WD, explore the tracks amongst the Coorong).

The Raukkan Aboriginal community is a beautiful spot to visit. Here you can learn about the home of famed Ngarrindjeri man David Uniapon, visit the church on the \$50 note, take in Coorong views on the new walking trail, or spend time on the nature playground.

If you have the time, drop in to visit the famed <u>Coonalpyn silo art</u> and grab some waffles, or if you're heading further south swing past Tintinara's Lake Indawarra.

A Place to Relax



Langhorne Creek

If you choose to cross the ferry at Wellington, you'll be driving along the edge of Lake Alexandrina towards the Langhorne Creek Wine Region. Make sure you stop at Kimbolton Wines, with its incredible rooftop deck, refreshing rose, cheese tasting plates and brilliant hospitality. Just down the road, Bremerton has expanded its cellar door - so there's plenty of space to play, eat and drink - and you need to try their new small batch gin flavours with a flight out on the lawns. Other wineries to visit include Lake Breeze, Bleasdale, Angas Plains, Vineyard Road, The Winehouse, Windsong Wines and Rusticana.

Goolwa

If you're following the Murray River, your trip will finish in Goolwa. the home of the Murray Mouth. This beautiful riverside town is home to the award-winning biennial South Australian Wooden Boat Festival, which returns in 2024. If you love river history, or just want to experience something new take a trip on the PS Oscar W. The Goolwa wharf is a great place to explore from, and has community markets on the first and third Sunday of every month. Otherwise, finish your trip with a quick adventure over the bridge to Hindmarsh Island. Here you can spend time at the marina hotel, or head out to Sugars Beach to see where the river meets the sea.

Pinnaroo and Lameroo

These two gorgeous Mallee towns are the perfect stopping point before the Victorian border. Their town centres are being redeveloped with new playgrounds, splash parks, pump tracks, picnic areas and more. If you love history, stop at the Mallee Tourist and Heritage Centre to see the historic letterpress printing display. For those seeking adventure (and love a 4WD challenge) grab yourself a coffee from local favourite the Groundsman and head to to Ngarkat Conservation Park where you can drive the famed border track.

Whether you're a stargazer, astrophotographer or simply love the great outdoors, the River Murray International Dark Sky Reserve should be on your bucket list.

The 3,200 square kilometre area (some of which falls within the Swan Reach Conservation Park) has some of the

darkest skies you'll see. The reserve is the first of its kind in Australia, and one of only 16 in the world. Darkness measures 21.97 out of 22 at the reserve's core location, drawing photographers and astronomers from all over the world in search of the best views of the Milky Way.

Experience Juggle House Experience's award-winning 'Dark Sky Gold Stars' tour with experts in astronomy and Aboriginal Custodians guiding you through the Ngaut Ngaut Conservation Park. Big Bend by Night and the PS Marion also offer tours.

With the best time to view late at night during complete darkness, visitors should make the most of their

> adventure and stay the night in the nearby towns of Swan Reach, Walker Flat, Punyelroo, Cambrai, Sedan, Purnong or Caurnamont.

Driving on country roads

What you need to know before you visit

The reserve is about 90 minutes from Adelaide, or 10 minutes from Mannum. You don't need fancy equipment out here. A pair of binoculars will do the trick for beginners. Or just sit back and look up.

The reserve contains several astro hotspots and ideal places for stargazing (see a list of sites on themurrayriver.com). If you're a keen stargazer, set up your telescope on the specially made concrete pads.

If you love camping, find a spot in our conservation park or local river reserves, and soak up the beautiful night sky.

If you're not an experienced camper, we suggest an organised tour and overnight accommodation through one of our great local caravan parks, cabins, motels, riverside holiday homes or houseboat.


